All BLI homestay families are located within a reasonable distance from the school.

BLI offers 4 types of homestay accommodation:

- Full-board (3 meals per day)
- Half-board (2 meals per day, breakfast and dinner)
- Room stay (no meals)



Student Residences

Living like a local

Residence accommodation is an option for students who enjoy the independence and privacy of living on their own.

You will have a private or shared room, according to your specific request(s).

Depending on the option chosen, kitchen, bath, and laundry facilities may be shared with other students.

Alternative Accommodation

Freedom and comfort

If you are looking for something outside of the traditional homestay or student residence options, we have a variety of alternatives to offer you, including student houses, shared housing, furnished apartments, and studios.

These are great options if you require more privacy and autonomy.

Other Services

Medical Insurance

Medical insurance is mandatory for all international students coming to Canada. When you register for any of our courses you can make a request and BLI will provide you with emergency medical insurance that covers and protects you during your stay and will give you all the information on how to use it.

Visa & CAQ Support

If you are planning to study at BLI for longer than six months, there are two documents you must have: a Canadian Study Permit and the CAQ (Quebec Acceptance Certificate). If this is the case you have to apply for the CAQ first. After getting your CAQ (this takes 3-6 weeks) you can start the process of obtaining your Canadian Study Permit.

Airport Transfers

At BLI, we want your experience abroad to be pleasant from the very first moment you arrive in Canada. We offer a personalized pick-up service. You will be picked up by one of our representatives who will make sure you arrive at your selected accommodation safely.

Part time 18 Lessons

The part-time program gives you the opportunity to review and practice all aspects of language learning, covering all four skills (reading, writing, speaking, and listening), grammar, and vocabulary. The approach is communicative and the classes are designed to be dynamic and engaging.

Full time 24 Lessons

Intensive 30 Lessons

Through a combination of task-based learning and traditional skills lessons, you will be a part of a class with a specific goal in mind where all areas of language use are activated naturally and effectively.

Super Intensive 35 Lessons

Super Intensive classes go even further! Here you will work closely with your teacher in smaller groups to help you reach your goals outside of the school environment. You might be learning transferable skills such as how to deliver an effective and engaging presentation, or furthering your career by studying International Business English or Exam Preparation; with the Super Intensive package, you are learning more than simply English.

Part time (PM) 18 Lessons



This option will give you an opportunity to review and practice all aspects of language learning, covering all four skills (reading, writing, speaking, and listening), grammar, and vocabulary. The approach is very communicative and the classes are designed to be dynamic and engaging.

Bilingual 42 Lessons

BLI bilingual program gives you the opportunity to learn, review and practice all aspects of language learning, covering all four skills (reading, writing, speaking, and listening), grammar, and vocabulary for both French and English. The bilingual program consists of French classes in the morning and English classes in the afternoon. The approach is communicative and student-centered and the classes are dynamic and engaging.

Class Description

General ESL/FSL



accuracy, fluency, and competency level in English and French. This is an interactive class where students have an opportunity to use grammar and learn about the rules through discovery, with the guidance of the teacher and some explicit explanations. More emphasis is placed on being able to communicate using the grammar point, which is why there are so many opportunities to practice and improve. Students will be able to practice the four language skills (listening, speaking, reading, and writing) in an integrated setting. Communication Workshop



This course practices core English/French functions and is structured around themes designed to improve natural everyday communication skills. The goal of this class is to develop fluency. There is a focus on speaking and interaction among students so that they can apply what they learned in their previous classes. The class is interactive and encourages team and group work in order to accomplish the goal of interacting like a native speaker and challenges students through tasks and project based activities such as role-plays, debates, discussion, story-telling, communicative or vocabulary games, and mini projects.

Specialized Elective ESL/FSL



This class is designed to help you speed up your learning process while allowing you the opportunity to select courses based on your specific interests and needs. Every session we offer a different specialized English/French course with a specific theme or central focus, such as English/French in films and music. Because there tend to be fewer students in this class, there is more individualized attention from the teacher.

Power Skills



This class will enhance your knowledge of specific language skills through various exercises and dynamic activities. Every session, there is a different focus, such as reading, writing, listening, speaking, vocabulary, and expressions, including idioms, as well as pronunciation and task-based learning. There are different sections that are tailored for each level, from beginner to advanced. You can practice your writing skills by producing a school newspaper, or develop your listening abilities by exploring the world of radio and podcasts.
